8. Applications for Joining AHWP

- A. The Regulatory Authority of any countries/economies interested in joining AHWP shall send the application form to the Secretariat. If the application comes from any organization rather than the government Regulatory Authority, a letter from the corresponding government Regulatory Authority nominating such organization as representative for discussion on joining of member economy is required. Such organization shall appoint its representative and inform the Secretariat accordingly.
- B. The Secretariat shall inform the AHWP Chair upon the confirmation of the application.
- C. The applicants will be invited to attend the next AHWP Meeting where voting on their applications will take place.

8. Applications for Joining AHWP

D. AHWP Liaison Membership

- 1) The Liaison Membership is open to the regional and international organizations who wish to join AHWP and with their goals in-line with the work of AHWP towards harmonization of medical device regulations.
- 2) Any organization interested in joining AHWP as a Liaison Member shall send their request to AHWP with attention to AHWP Chair and cc AHWP Secretariat at secretariat@ahwp.info.
- 3) AHWP shall evaluate and determine the suitability of the applying organization for joining AHWP as a Liaison Member.
- 4) AHWP Chair shall have the rights to reject any AHWP Liaison Membership application.
- 5) Once the Liaison Membership application is confirmed, an official letter of confirmation from the AHWP Chair will be send via AHWP Secretariat to the new Liaison Member.

8. Applications for Joining AHWP

- D. AHWP Liaison Membership
 - 6) The confirmed Liaison Member shall nominate a representative and subscribe to AHWP Secretariat as the contact person.
 - 7) Liaison Member of AHWP shall have higher priority to co-organizing activities with AHWP.
 - 8) The representative from Liaison Member can be an observer; however, shall not have voting rights in AHWP meetings.
 - 9) The full list of Liaison Members of AHWP as well as the contacts of the corresponding representatives shall be kept by the AHWP Secretariat for record.
 - 10) The list of Liaison Members of AHWP shall also be available at AHWP website.

11. Hosting AHWP and AHWPTC Meetings

- B. In the planning of a Meeting, the host member shall ensure that the event will be self-financed while sponsorships may be sought if needed.
 There shall be a contingency plan for the settlement of deficits that may arise.
- C. The host member shall prepare a financial statement for posting on the AHWP website after the completion of the event. The surplus should be contributed to the AHWP Reserve.

- 4. The Meetings of AHWP and/or its Technical Committee and the various programmes for the event will be entirely self-funding. AHWP will provide a seed fund to manage cashflow. [AHWP and AHWP Administration Services Limited (ASL), through the AHWP Secretariat, will review the seed fund request, meeting budget, meeting sponsorship income status and ASL financial status by the moment the request is received, and decide the seed fund amount] Each delegate shall pay his share of the cost for attending the event. Cost of any pre- and post-event local tours arranged outside the event's programme shall be borne by individual delegate.

Sponsorships, if any, from multinational companies will be directly collected by AHWP ASL through the Secretariat.

5. Member Economy's host organization and the local industry association will undertake to manage the following services and support:

Post-Event:

x) The meeting total income will include registration income, sponsorships received by local host and sponsorships received by AHWP ASL. The meeting total expenses will include meeting direct expenses generated in the local host side and the direct expenses generated in AHWP ASL side. The meeting surplus will be based on total income and total expenses. The meeting local host shall prepare an contingency plan in case for any deficiency.



Review of ASL M&A

• Background

 There are some ambiguous areas and conflictions within the Memorandum and Articles of Association (M&A) of AHWP ASL, regarding to membership and voting.

2. The Members of the Company shall consist of:

- 1) Regulator Members;
- 2) Industry Members; and
- 3) Associate Members.

Regulator Members and Industry Members are collectively referred to as the "Voting Members".

"Company" means AHWP ADMINISTRATION SERVICES LIMITED.

3. Individuals from member economies of the Asian Harmonization Working Party that support the missions, goals and objects of the Company as set out in the Memorandum of Association are eligible to apply for membership as Regulator Member, Industry Member or Associate Member as appropriate.

- 6. Associate Members

Summary:

a)Regulatory member and industry member are from AHWP member economies

b)Each AHWP member economy can have:-

- maximally 1 Regulator Member and
- maximally 1 Industry Member.

c)Regulatory Members and Industry Members are voting

6. Associate Member

(2)The number of Associate Members from any economy (whether or not it is an economy of the Asian Harmonization Working Party) shall not exceed one hundred (100).

(3)Associate Members shall have right to attend but no right to vote at general meetings.

Associate members could be from any economy. **is conflicting with** Individuals from AHWP member economies are eligible to apply for ASL membership.



BOARD OF DIRECTORS

37. The Directors of the Board shall be a member of the Company and shall be elected at the annual general meetings when their respective terms of appointment expire.

Discussion:

The Directors could be elected from an associate member.

However, associate members have no right to vote at a general meeting. Proposed amendment:

Any associate member, once elected as a Director of the Board, shall have the right to vote at a general meeting.
